

LIONS' PRIDE SPIRIT ROCK – FAQ

What is the Lions' Pride Spirit Rock?

The Lions' Pride Spirit Rock is a painted rock near the “Fire Up Lions!” gate that families may reserve to celebrate birthdays, milestones, achievements, and special occasions—all while supporting the HTLS PTO.

Where is the Lions' Pride Spirit Rock located?

The rock is located beside the “Fire Up Lions!” gate near the large playground on the south side of the HTLS/HTLC parking lot.

How much does it cost to reserve the rock?

A **\$20 donation** reserves the Lions' Pride Spirit Rock for one full day (24 hours).

What time does my reservation begin and end?

Reservations run from **4:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.**

You may begin painting at **4:00 p.m. the day before** your reserved date, and your design may remain until **4:00 p.m. on the reserved date.**

How do I reserve the Lions' Pride Spirit Rock?

1. Check the [Spirit Rock Calendar](#) to find an available date.
2. Complete the [Reservation Form](#) on Zeffy, and submit your \$20 donation.
3. You will receive a confirmation email with painting tips and reminders.

What kind of paint should we use?

Most families use a combination of **spray paint and acrylic paint**. Spray paint (such as Ironlak, available at Hobby Lobby) works best for background/base coats and dries very quickly. Acrylic paint is ideal for details and typically dries in about **15 minutes** between coats. More painting tips and suggestions will be included in your confirmation email.

Can my child paint the rock alone?

No. Children and minors must paint with **parent or guardian supervision** at all times.

What can we paint on the rock?

Painted designs must be **respectful, school-appropriate, and non-political**, and must align with the **HTLS School Code of Conduct**. Profanity, discriminatory language, and political messages are not permitted.

What happens if weather is rainy/bad?

Weather is always unpredictable. Families should plan accordingly. Paid reservations are non-refundable, but we'll do our best to give you a new date! Spray paint dries almost immediately and Ironlak Spray Paint (available at Hobby Lobby) is especially effective.

What if someone paints over our design early?

While rare, HTLS PTO cannot be responsible for accidental or intentional repainting by others. The 4 p.m. start the day before a reservation is firm.

Does the PTO provide paint or supplies?

No. All paint, supplies, and labor are provided by the reserving family.
